**5. Action Taken Report: 2018 [Refer Annexure-1]**

- a. IQAC coordinator presented the detailed action taken report of the year 2018 which is summarized below:
- Initiatives discussed & recommended : 34
  - Action Taken & implemented : 23: 68 %
  - Attempted & in process: 08: 24 %

- b. IQAC coordinator discussed the initiatives which could not be implemented. One of the initiatives was to offer full-time Ph.D. course with stipend to attract the quality candidates. Principal informed to prepare the guidelines / proposal which could be sent for approval from the management.

**Decision:** It was decided to draft the guideline / proposal for offering Ph.D. course with stipend.

- c. IQAC coordinator informed that the remaining initiatives would be taken / followed up this year.
- d. IQAC coordinator thanked all the members for their active cooperation and constructive suggestions in the year 2018, which helped to materialize the initiatives made and recommended from the board.

#### 6. Academic and Administrative Audit

- a. IQAC coordinator presented a brief overview of this subject. He told that this was the subject placed in 21<sup>st</sup> meeting on 30.10.2018 and it was decided to implement Academic & Administrative Audit in the institute. He placed the following proposal before the members and sought for their opinion:

I. As per NAAC guidelines, Internal Audit has to be conducted annually and external audit to be conducted 3 years once.

II. Internal Audit team could be formed comprising of following members:

- Vice Principal : Chairman ; IQAC Coordinator ; NBA Coordinator ; Member, IQAC ; Member, NBA Committee

III. External Audit Team to be formed

- b. All the members endorsed the internal team composition. Dr. M G Krishnamurthy, Member, IQAC was nominated as one of the members. It was decided to nominate a member from NBA committee as advised by the NBA coordinator. This committee would be the core committee of Internal Audit. This committee would design and finalise the Audit guidelines / check list in line with the NAAC guidelines. Tentatively committee will meet within 15.3.2019 to discuss about the draft Audit guidelines. Later, in the month of June of every year the core committee will formulate the three audit teams choosing the members from NBA committee, IQAC and Academic Monitoring Committee. This audit team will be trained about the AAA auditing procedure and the guidelines.
- c. The Audit guidelines will be placed in the next meeting for final approval.
- d. In the mean time, it was decided to choose the external audit team members from the known contacts and based on their expertise.

#### 7. Relook and follow up of Academic Process Improvement

- a. IQAC Coordinator presented the subject. He proposed that as per the NBA / NAAC guidelines defining and the continuous follow up is required for the following:

I. Periodical Feedback from the Departments about Academic Process

II. Effective Student Mentoring

III. Identification of Bright and Weak Students

- Effective Implementation of Remedial Classes for Weak Students
- Encouraging Bright Students

IV. Effective implementation of Preparatory Exam for I Year Students

- b. Vice Principal was of the opinion that for the effective implementation of any academic activity there has to be a deadline and the faculty members should adhere to that deadline. In the process defined there should be mention about the penal action if the deadline was not met.
- c. Principal informed that all the academic activities could be monitored using OAM software. Faculty members should be asked to use the OAM software affectively so that all the activities could be tracked based on the data / reports available in the OAM software.
- d. Ms. Savitha Madhav informed the members about the frequent change of class time table was an issue in the usage of OAM software.
- e. Dr. Hemamalini informed that Mentoring Activity template was available which could be used for mentoring process by the faculty members.

**Decision:** Members decided to direct the Academic Monitoring Committee to design the process to follow up the above listed academic activity. Also, AMC was directed to call a member from Student Mentoring Committee to finalise the mentoring process. Later, the resolutions may be placed before in the next IQAC meeting for final approval / ratification.

As there was no other subject, the meeting concluded, with the Coordinator thanking all the members for their active participation.
