3. Proceedings:

- 1. After welcoming all the members to the meeting, the IQAC Coordinator placed before the members the agenda of the meeting, which was alreadycirculated along with the meeting notice.
- 2. The Chairman-IQAC (Principal) in his initial remarkspresented briefly the highlights of the agenda of the meeting.
- 3. IQAC Coordinator gave a brief review of previous meeting proceedings and the action taken thereon:
 - a. Alumni Association registration was registered bearing registration number DRSH/SOR/74/2018-2019
 - b. NAAC coordinators' meeting was held on 25.6.2018 and preparations required for NAAC revisit were discussed. The following decisions were taken in the meeting:
 - i. NAAC awareness program for the staff of the institution was planned during 12.7.2018. It would be conducted in three groups:
 - Group A: ECE, TCE, EE departments
 - Group B: CSE, ISE, MCA departments
 - Group C: Mechanical, Civil, MBA departments
 - Group D: Office staff, Basic Science departments
 - ii. Preparation of an additional report of the updations in facilities / activities from 1.4.2017 to till date and this work was distributed criteria-wise, among the NAAC coordinators.
 - iii. Display boards required have to be planned by all the respective department coordinators and informed to the IQAC coordinator.
 - c. Project Exhibition held on 19.6.2018 was a grand success
 - i. Exhibition was inaugurated by Sri. K. S. Eshwarappa, MLA, Shivamogga
 - ii. Around 40 projects were exhibited out of 200 projects of final year students of all 7 departments
 - iii. Best project was awarded with a cash award and a certificate in each department
 - iv. Wide publicity was given by all the news papers
 - d. List of best projects department-wise presented with some photos of the exhibition, which were appreciated by all the members.
- 4. IQAC Coordinator presented some of the updates and some of the programs conducted in the institution and at department level:

a. Programs organized by the departments:

i. Department of Library & Information Centre, in association with DELNET, New Delhi organized a one-day Regional Workshop on 29.5.2018 on "Strategies for Transforming Libraries, Growing Trends and Technologies.Prof. K. Prasad, Regional Joint Director, Dept. of Collegiate Education, Govt. of Karnataka inaugurated the workshop.

- Sri. S. N. Nagaraja, Secretary, NES, Shivamogga and Dr. H. R. Mahadevaswamy, Principal, JNNCE had graced the occasion. The program was presided over by Dr. H. K. Koul, Director, DELNET. The workshop was attended by 50+ delegates comprising of Library Professionals, Research Scholars, faculty and students.
- ii. International Conference: MPCIT 2018 by ECE & TCE Departments during 8-9, June 2018.
 - 62 Papers received; 50 Papers accepted; 30 Papers registered; and
 11 Papers presented
 - Inauguration & Keynote Address: Dr. A. G. Ramakrishnan, Professor, IISc, Bangalore
 - 6 Invited talks in various fields related to the theme of the conference
 - Guests of Honor& Invited Speakers: Dr. Harish Chouhan, Dr. D S Guru, Mysore University, Dr. G. K Patra, CSIR, Bangalore, Sri. VeeredraMittal, BEL, Bangalore, Ms PallaviArora, CISCO, Bangalore
 - Conference Inaugural program was covered by all the leading news papers

5. Bridge Course for Newly admitted first year B.E. students

- a. IQAC coordinator presented the context and objectives of the bridge course. He also proposed the plan and syllabus of the course.
- b. It was decided to organize the bridge course for duration of one week during first week of August, 2018 keeping, the VTU curriculum as the reference.
- c. Dr. L. K. Sreepathi, Vice Principal and the Dr. C. G. Hemamalini, Professor, Civil Engineering Member were given the responsibility of framing the structure and syllabus of the course.
- d. It was expressed by most of the members that there should be a good mix of practical and theory demonstrating the application of Science in Engineering.

6. Internship for 6thSem B.E. Students

- a. IQAC Coordinator presented the current status about the students who have already placed for internships. Also, he communicated the mail received by Ms. Rasmi Sooryanarayana – Centre Head, DXC Tech & Member IQAC, stating that DXC Tech. would offer Internships for one or two Students in the area of Machine Learning / Image Processing & Online Internships to some selected students.
- b. Principal remarked that most of the Civil Engineering and Mechanical Engineering students were placed for internships. Attempts were being made for placing the students for internships in other branches.

c. It was decided to organize one month training – Professional Practice for the students who did not offer internships in companies during the 7th Semester vacation period by Industry Professionals.

7. Compilation and Printing of College Handbook and Prospectus 2018-19

 a. It was decided to include IQAC details and Program Outcomes in the Handbook 2018-19.

8. Review of NBA Preparation

- a. IQAC coordinator presented the following regarding NBA process in the institution:
 - i. Present Status:
 - NBA Committee was being reframed
 - Faculty are updating course file as per OBE requirement
 - ii. Tasks to be taken up:
 - Internal audit of OBE status in all departments
 - Pre-qualifier report
- b. Principal updated about the NBA process stating that Pre-qualifier report pertaining to all the programs would be prepared soon and based upon this, readiness of OBE in various departments would be audited by framing an internal team.
- 9. Principal highlighted the proposal submitted to NSTEDB, DST, Govt. of India for setting up NewGen IDC which was shortlisted and called for presentation at Ahmedabad on 21st June 2018. In this scheme DST, Govt of India would fund the institution to start NewGen IEDC and provide funding upto Rs.50 lakhs per annum or more and is for 5 years. Further, he said that this proposal was applied, with Dr.H R Mahadevaswamy, Principal as the Coordinator and Sri. Mallesh Kumar K S, Regional Coordinator, NAIN, as the cocoordinator and out of 250 proposals, 24 proposals were shortlisted, which includeed the proposal submitted by our institution.
- 10. The meeting concluded, with the Chairman thanking all the members for their active participation.
