3. Proceedings:


1. After welcoming all the members to the meeting, the IQAC Coordinator placed before the members the agenda of the meeting, which was already circulated along with the meeting notice.
2. The Chairman-IQAC (Principal) in his initial remarks presented the highlights of Global Alumni Meet held on 19th May 2018. Also, he apprised about the three MOUs which were signed during the Alumni Meet to set up Structural Engg. Lab and help of Alumni in placement. Further, he said that process is on to give technical knowhow to set up Bio Diesel Plant at Jharkhand State with the help of Mr. Ashok Pradhan, Alumni of Civil Dept.
3. IQAC Coordinator gave a brief review of previous meeting proceedings and the action taken thereon:
 - a. Alumni Association registration was in progress – yet to receive the Registration Number.
 - b. NAAC revisit intimation was received on 24.4.2018 and five copies of SSR were dispatched on 7.5.2018 to NAAC office.
 - c. Global Alumni Meet held on 19.5.2018 was a grand success
 - i. Around 175 Alumni had participated
 - ii. Mr. K . S. Sundar , Associate Vice - President, Infosys, Mysore was the chief guest and delivered inaugural address
 - iii. 11 Alumni awarded with “Distinguished Alumni Award”
 - iv. A Souvenir was released
 - v. General Body Meeting was convened and it was resolved to organize Alumni Meet on Third Saturday of May every Year.
 - vi. Sports for Alumni Family Members and Cultural Program by students and Alumni were arranged and enjoyed by all the participants
 - vii. **Outcome of the meet: 3 MOUs were signed**

4. IQAC Coordinator presented some of the updates and some of the programs conducted in the institution and at department level:
- a. **TECHZONE – 2018: National Level Technical Fest: from 27.4.2018 to 29.4.2018:** 25 technical competitions were conducted and students from around 10 colleges participated in the event.
 - b. **Graduands Day :**
 - i. **Celebrated on 23.5.2018 – 821 U G students and 231 PG students of Final year participated**
 - ii. Dr. Rangarajan, Former Director, ISRO was the Chief Guest
 - iii. **11 students were conferred with Distinguished Outgoing Student Awards**
 - JNNCE Excellence Award, JNNCE Young Innovator and Entrepreneur Award, JNNCE Ramanujam Award, JNNCE Khel Ratna Award, JNNCE Kala Ratna Award – Instituted by Principal Dr. H. R. Mahadevaswamy, which includes Rs.1000/- cash award and a Certificate
 - JNNCE Paripurna Award – Instituted by Mr. Vinay Kaul, Principal Lead & Advisor, Oracle India: Alumni: 2004 – Civil Engg. Dept, which includes Rs. 5000/- cash award and a Certificate

The members appreciated both the Principal and the Alumni for instituting these awards.
 - c. **Programs organized by the departments:**
 - Management Day & alumni Meet by MBA Department on 6th May 2018 – 120 Alumni participated – Various cultural events and Management related events were organized for the students.
 - National Seminar on **CURRENT TRENDS IN NANO TECHNOLOGY** on 14th May 2018 – organized by Chemistry Department
 - Around 50 students from the college and 30 delegates from various Colleges / Universities have attended the seminar
 - **Dr. Syed Akheel Ahmed**, former Vice Chancellor, Yenepoya University Mangalore and Former Dean for Science and Technology, Mysore University delivered the Keynote address . **Mr. Adnan Javeed**, MD, Adnano technologies, Shivamogga, **Mr. Noeman Taqui**, Research Associate, Malaya University, Malaysia, **Dr. J. Manjanna**, Associate Professor and Chairman, Dept. of Chemistry, Rani Chennamma University, Belagavi and **Dr. M.M. Rajath Hegde**, Professor, Dept. of Mechanical Engineering, JNNCE-Shivamogga delivered the invited talks. **Dr. J. Keshavvaya**, Professor and Former Dean for Science and Technology, Department of Chemistry, Kuvempu University- Shivamogga was the chief guest for the Valedictory program.

- Forum Activities were organized by all the Engineering departments
- d. IQAC Coordinator also updated the progress about the International Conference: MPCIT 2018 being organized by ECE & TCE Departments.
 - e. Updates about NBA Process:
 - i. Course attainment Excel Sheet was circulated to all the departments
 - ii. Faculty members were asked to compute the course attainment for the subjects they had handled in previous semesters.
 - f. JNNCE HR Manual was released on 15.5.2018 which is a mandatory requirement of VTU, NBA & NAAC and contains the service rules for all the JNNCE employees.
5. Ms. Rashmi Sooryanarayana requested the Principal to upgrade the alumni website so that alumni could interact through this alumni portal. She was also suggested to start multiple alumni chapters in each region, resolved in the General Body Meeting during Global Alumni meet. It was resolved to start all these activities after the completion of Alumni Association registration process.
 6. It was resolved to plan NAAC Mock visit in two stages. One, by the teams comprising of in-house faculty members and another by an external agency /expert.
 7. IQAC coordinator was also suggested to prepare a report comprising of updates / improvements after October 2017 (previous NAAC visit).
 8. It was decided to convene NAAC department Coordinators meeting to plan and review the preparations for NAAC revisit during second week of June 2018.
 9. **Academic process automation:** Principal updated about the plan of procuring Academic automation software. He presented the module wise design of academic software requirement. He also informed that quotations were called and short listing & finalization of the venders has been planned in the first week of June.
 10. **Final Year Project Exhibition:** IQAC coordinator discussed the plan of organizing the Final Year Project Exhibition on 19.6.2018. Best Five projects from each department would be finalized for the exhibition. Exhibition would be arranged at Ananya Mantapa & Electronics Dept. Labs. Best Project award would be given to motivate the students.
