- Coordinator: Dr. S. V. Sathyanarayana, Professor, E & C

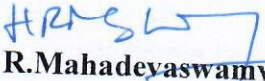
5. Quality initiatives in Teaching - Learning Process:

2017- 18 Batch: 363 students out of 787: 46%
