

3. Proceedings:

- **2.** IQAC Coordinator gave a brief review of previous meeting proceedings and the action taken

3. Agenda: Student Satisfaction Survey highlights

Coordinator Dr. Jalesh kumar presented student satisfaction survey comments given by students. Some of the comments are related to issues of online classes and lack of practical knowledge in Civil and Mechanical field. Dr. Sughosh suggested that Civil department is trying maximum effort in incorporating practical experience to students. Sri. S N Nagaraja discussed about involving students with Smartcity related projects and suggested to think in the areas of solid waste management and sewage water management.

Recommendations:

- Webinars about latest materials and latest technologies shall be arranged by Civil and Mechanical departments
- Provide Internship to the students in Smart city and NHAI related projects

4. Agenda: Project Impact Analysis of 2020-21

Dr. Chetan K R informed that all the activities carried out related to the projects are recorded in automation software JAMS. Coordinator Dr. Jalesh Kumar suggested impact of final year projects of 2020-21 batch shall be analyzed. Dr. P Manjunath informed that departments are planning final year project exhibition.

Recommendations:

- Departments are informed to prepare Compendium of final year project information
- JAMS shall provide an interface to collect synopsis of project from students
- Encourage students to bring outcomes of project work in terms of publications

5. Agenda: Placement Analysis

Placement head Dr. Srikanth briefed about placement details of 2020-21. It is observed from the analysis that students in between 1.8 to 3.5 package is more in number. Sr. S. N. Nagaraja suggested to provide more opportunity of higher packages to students.

Recommendations:

- Training based on competency level
- Mentors to track the respective student placement details

6. Agenda: Performance indicators

Sri. S.N. Nagaraj explained the format of performance indicators for faculty members to be followed from academic year 2021-22. The template is shown to all the members.
