

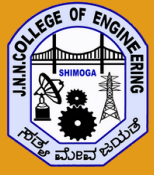

- Conferences: National:** 50% Registration and TA/DA  
**International Conference:** 100% Registration fee and TA/DA
- Publication of Book:** International Publisher: Rs.25,000/- and National Publisher: Rs.15000/-
- Product Development:** Rs. 50,000/-, if it is commercialized
- Incentive for getting the Grant from Government/Private Sponsored projects:** 5% of total grant if grant is from Government agency and 10% - from Private Agencies
- Professional Memberships:** Membership fee will be reimbursed (Conditions apply)
- SEED Money:** Grants shall be awarded with a maximum value of Rs.10Lakhs including the research grant received from other agencies.

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8. Incentive for Scholars (Full time Ph. D Scholars) / Students to attend Conferences/Competitions
9. Incentive for Students winning National level/state level / Project competition/Hackathons
10. FDP/SDP for Students and faculty members: Sponsorship of Rs.5,000/- shall be given to faculty and students to attend FDP/SDP. FDP must be minimum of 5 days' duration.
11. **Best Researcher Award (Department wise)** - Research award will be given based on well defined rubrics
12. **Innovation Award:** Innovation award will be given based on well defined rubrics
13. **Best Thesis Award:** Best Thesis award will be given based on well defined rubrics
14. **Best Project Award:** Best Project award will be given based on well defined rubrics.
15. **Policy for Full-Time research assistants/ Research scholars/Research associates:** All the scholars enrolled for Ph.D. in full-time mode are provided with a stipend of Rs.20,000/- per month for three years and the hostel facility at a cost of 1,500/-p.m.

# JNNCE RESEARCH PROMOTION POLICY 2024-25

## I. Introduction

JNNCE is dedicated to Research as a source of new knowledge and social development in line with its Vision, Mission and Quality Policy of “Social Responsibility” and “Pursuit of Excellence”. The institution shall promote vibrant Research culture at all its departments among its students and faculty, thereby being a nurturing ground for innovative ideas and applications.

The institution will also promote collaborative and interdisciplinary Research among the students, and faculty with other Institutions, Organizations and Industries. The Research and Development facilities shall be regularly maintained and scaled up to facilitate current research trends in knowledge acquisition, methodologies, and technical advancements.

The well-established Research promotion policy is to reassure the faculty and students to contribute to Research and Development on priority facets of society and mankind. The Academic Research at institution in development and allied fields shall yield a plethora of evidence-based knowledge that will prove important to society and organizations. The policy will serve as a larger framework within which all Research activities are conceived and implemented.

The Research promotion policy will be guided by the Research Advisory Board (RAB) chaired by the Principal. Under the guidance of the Research Advisory Board and the Dean (Research), the Centre for Research ensures that various Research-related regulations are adhered to by all Departments.

## II. Objectives

The primary objective of the proposed incentive scheme is to motivate all the faculty members / scholars of our institution to undertake Quality Research, Consultancy and other Research related activities.

The Research Advisory Board intends to create an ecosystem of Research and innovation by implementing the following steps:

1. Foster a culture that nurtures creative thinking that enables faculty and students to propose original and innovative ideas, concepts, products, and processes.
2. Encourage and support collaboration with industries, Research communities, Academic institutions, and colleagues to realize their ideas.
3. Motivate faculty and students to engage in innovative research activities aimed at addressing societal and industrial problems.
4. Approach premier funding Institutes to develop Research Infrastructure and seek financial support for carrying out research.
5. Reward faculty and students appropriately for conducting research that yields valuable outcomes, such as the publication of Research articles, books, and monographs through reputable publishers.
6. Establish centers of excellence in emerging areas of Engineering, technology and Management.



The JNNCE Research Advisory Board facilitates brainstorming sessions to gather ideas that warrant further research intervention. Additionally, it aims to educate faculty and students on research paper writing, Intellectual Property Rights, and preparing research proposals for funding.
