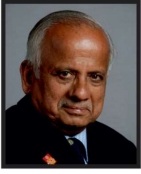

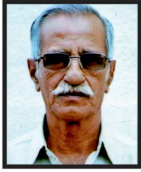

Assessment and Accreditation

Assessment is the systematic basis for making inferences about the learning and development of students. It is the process of defining, selecting, designing, collecting, analyzing, interpreting, and using information to increase students' learning and development. Process of Assessment begins with the goals for student learning articulated in the College Mission and Outcomes Statements. These institutional goals are implemented at the program and course levels. Assessment at these levels provides information that enables the College to determine the extent to which its goals for student learning are being met. Assessment data also guides revision at the program and course levels designed to enhance student learning.

Accreditation is a process of quality assurance and improvement, whereby a program in an approved Institution is critically appraised to verify that the Institution or the program continues to meet and/or exceed the Norms and Standards prescribed by regulator from time to time. Accreditation is advancement and upgrading of programs and performance in higher education institutions.

Accreditation Agencies:

NAAC: National Assessment and Accreditation Council: is an autonomous body established by the University Grants Commission (UGC) to assess and accreditate institutions of higher education in the country. The NAAC was established in 1994 with its headquarters at Bangalore.

NBA: National Board of Accreditation: NBA was established in the year 1994 under Section 10 (u) of AICTE Act. NBA became Autonomous in January 2010 and in April 2013 the Memorandum of Association and Rules of NBA were amended to make it completely independent both administrative as well as financial. NBA became a permanent member of the Washington Accord (an international accord) in 2014.

NBA assess the curriculum design, Teaching-Learning Process with extent of Outcome Based Education Practice, Research & Consultancy, Infrastructure, Student Progression, Governance and the best practices adapted by the institution and accreditates the program (Department).

VTU Regulations

Highlights of 2022 Scheme for 1st year students

Outcome-Based Education(OBE)and Choice Based Credit System(CBCS) is effective from the academic year 2022-23. The 1st year courses include the following:

- SDA-Skill Development Activities
- ASC-Applied Science Course
- ESC-Engineering Science Courses
- ETC-Emerging Technology Course
- AEC-Ability Enhancement Course
- HSMS-Humanity and Social Science and Management Course
- SDC-Skill Development Course
- CIE-Continuous Internal Evaluation
- SEE-Semester End Examination
- IC-Integrated Course (Theory Integrated with Practical)

Student's Induction Program: Provides newly admitted students a broad understanding of society, relationships, and values, along with the knowledge and skill of his/her study, students' character needs to be nurtured as an essential quality by which he/she would understand and fulfil the responsibility as an engineer. This program includes Physical Activity, Creative Arts, Universal Human Values, Literary, Proficiency Modules, Lectures by Eminent People, Visits to Local areas, Familiarization with Department/Branch and Innovation, etc.

AICTE Activity Points: These points are to be earned by students admitted to 1st year, over and above the academic grades. A student shall earn 100 Activity Points (75 points for lateral entry students) respectively for the award of degree through AICTE Activity Point Program. The Activity Points earned shall be reflected on the student's eighth semester Grade Card. The activities can be spread over the years, any time during the semester weekends, and holidays from the year of entry to the program. Activity Points (non-credit) do not affect SGPA/CGPA and shall not be considered for vertical progression. In case students fail to earn the prescribed activity points, an eighth Semester grade card shall be issued only after earning the required activity points. Students shall be admitted for the award of the degree only after the release of the eighth semester grade card.



ESC or ETC Courses: These are 03 credits Courses and have only a theory component or if the nature the of course required experimental learning syllabus shall be designed as an Integrated course. The student has to select one course from the ESC-I group. For example, EEE Students shall opt for any one of the courses from the ESC-I group except, 22ESC142- Introduction to Electrical Engineering and ECE/ETC/BM/ML students shall opt any one of the courses from ESC-I except 22ESC143 Introduction to Electronics Engineering. The students have to opt for the courses from ESC group without repeating the course in either 1st or 2nd semester. The students must select one course from either ETC-I or PLC-I group. If students study the subject from ETC-I in 1st semester, he/she has to select the course from PLC-II in the 2nd semester and vice-versa.

One credit Courses: These courses have the SEE of 01-hour duration and the pattern of the question paper will be MCQ.

Assessment Details (both CIE and SEE)

The weightage of Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) is 50% and for Semester End Exam (SEE) is 50%. The minimum passing mark for the CIE is 40% of the maximum marks. The minimum passing mark for the SEE is 35% of the maximum marks. A student shall be deemed to have satisfied the academic requirements and earned the credits allotted to each subject/course if the student secures not less than 35% in the semester-end examination(SEE), and a minimum of 40% in the total of the CIE (Continuous Internal Evaluation) and SEE (Semester End Examination) taken together.

A. Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE):

1. Minimum CIE marks for all theory courses is 40 % of the marks prescribed for CIE.
2. For Non-Credit Mandatory Course (NCMC) minimum marks to be scored in 40% of prescribed CIE marks. The courses will not be considered for vertical progression and CGPA Calculation but completion of course is mandatory for award of degree.
3. Students satisfying the attendance but failing to secure the prescribed minimum marks shall not be eligible for the SEE.

B. Semester End Examinations (SEE):

1. SEE is conducted by university for maximum 100 marks and proportionally scaled down to 50 marks.



- For theory and drawing courses, minimum SEE marks to be secured is 35 % of maximum marks i.e., 18 marks.
- For practical/fieldwork, maximum SEE marks is 50 and minimum SEE marks to be secured is 35 % of 50 marks i.e., 18 marks.

SGPA and CGPA

- (i) The University adopts absolute grading system wherein the marks are converted to grades, and every semester results will be declared with Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) and Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA). The CGPA will be calculated for every semester, except for the first semester.
- (ii) The grading system with the letter grades and the assigned range of marks under absolute grading system are as given below:

Credit Points (CrP) = GP x Credit of the course

A student obtaining Grade F in a Course (subject) will be considered fail and is required to reappear in the subsequent SEE. Whatever the letter grade secured by the student in his/her reappearance shall be awarded. The number of attempts taken to clear courses/s shall be indicated in the grade card.

Calculation of SGPA and CGPA

The following expressions is being used to compute the Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) and Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) respectively:

$$\text{SGPA} = \frac{\sum[\text{Course Credits} \times \text{Grade Points}] \text{ for all the courses in that semester}}{\sum[\text{Course Credits}] \text{ for all the courses in that semester}}$$

$$\text{CGPA} = \frac{\sum[\text{Course Credits} \times \text{Grade Points}] \text{ for all the courses excluding those with F grades until that semester}}{\sum[\text{Course Credits}] \text{ for all the courses excluding those with F grades until that semester}}$$

Conversion of CGPA into percentage

There is no formula for the conversion of CGPA into the percentage of marks. However, the following formula for conversion of the CGPA on a 10 - point scale into the percentage of marks (M) for employment / higher studies, etc may be used;

Percentage of marks secured, $M = \text{CGPA Earned} \times 10$

Illustration for a CGPA of 8.20: $M = [\text{CGPA Earned } [8.20] \times 10 = 82.0 \%$

Class Equivalence

Subsequent to the conversion of final CGPA, after successful completion of the Programme, into percentage of marks (M), a graduating student is reckoned to have passed in

1. First Class with Distinction (FCD) if $M \geq 70\%$
2. First Class (FC) if $60\% \leq M < 70\%$.



3. Second Class (SC) if $50\% \leq M < 60\%$.

4. Pass Class (P) if $40\% \leq M < 50\%$.

Attendance Requirement

Each semester the candidates have to put in a minimum attendance of 85% in each course with a provision of condonation of 10% of the attendance by the Vice-Chancellor on the specific recommendations of the Principal of the college where the candidate is studying, based on medical grounds, participation in University/State/ National/ International level sports and cultural activities, seminars, workshops, paper presentation etc., of significant value. The supporting documents for condoning the shortage of attendance must be submitted along with the recommendations.

- a) The basis for the calculation of attendance will be the period prescribed by the University by its calendar of events.
- b) For course/s having lecture and tutorial hours, attendance is with respect to 85 % of attendance in lecture hours and 85 % of attendance in tutorial hours. If the attendance requirement is not satisfied in any one of them, the candidate will be considered as not satisfied the attendance condition. Condonation of 10 % can be applied separately to lecture and tutorial hour to make up the deficiency in attendance.
- c) In case of late admission, approved by competent authority (DTE/ VTU), to I semester, attendance will be reckoned from the date of admission to the college.

RULES AND DISCIPLINE

In order to maintain the sanctity and decorum in the campus and the hostels, the following rules of discipline to be observed by students:

- Ragging in any form is strictly banned in the College / Hostel / Outside the Campus / College Bus.
- Ragging means causing, inducing, compelling or forcing a student, by way of practical joke or otherwise any act which adversely affects the body or psyche of a fresher.
- Persons indulging in ragging are punishable under IPC sections 116, 109, 110, 111, 112, 113, 114, 115, 116, 302, 305, 306, 339, 340, 341, 342, 343, 344, 346, 347, 354, 359, 368, 448, 451 and 506, entailing inflictment of extreme punishment, as per standing order No. 940 of Director General & Inspector General of Police.
- Ragging is Non-Bailable offence and persons can be arrested immediately without any warrant.
- Persons watching, abetting ragging etc. are also punishable under IPC upto one year imprisonment and Heavy fine.
- Persons indulging in ragging shall be dismissed from college and hostel with immediate effect.
- Students who have finished their courses or final year students indulging in ragging, will be given their Degree certificate / Character & Conduct certificate / Passport superscribed "INDULGED IN RAGGING" in BOLD Letters.
- Persons who get slightest information regarding ragging should immediately contact the authorities and inform them.
- Consumption of Tobacco/Liquor/Drugs is banned in the Hostels /College Campus
- The students should behave courteously with the members of staff.
- They should maintain silence in the library, classrooms and work quietly in drawing halls, laboratories and workshops.
- Students coming late to the classes are not permitted to enter the class rooms.
- They should not meddle with machines, meters and tools in the laboratories and workshops without the permission of the staff members in charge. They will be responsible of the damages and will have to pay for their replacement.
- They should not absent themselves from the classes without the prior permission of the Principal.
- Students not satisfying the minimum attendance and sessional requirement will not be able to take the examinations.
- Students should take all the tests without fail.
- Students are forbidden from pasting posters in the institute premises and causing any damages to the property of the institute.
- Smoking, consumption of alcoholic beverages and drugs are strictly forbidden.
- Students are not to affix any notice or remove any office notice from the notice boards.



- In view of the university banning the usage of mobile phones in the college campus, students are informed not to carry mobile phones to the college campus, However they may use mobile phones in the hostel premises. Students are requested to take this arrangement positively as it will help them in not getting diverted from their academic work.
- Students using vehicles are required to leave them in parking places provided and are forbidden from parking in other places inside the campus causing disturbance to the classes.

Disciplinary Actions and Related Matters

- Violation of code of conduct and disciplinary rules of the institute will be referred to the Internal complaint committee.
- Violation of code of conduct shall attract disciplinary action which may include punishment such as reprimand, disciplinary probation, fine, debarring from the examination, withdrawal of placement facilities, withholding grades/degree, cancellation of registration and even rustication from the institute.

Provision for Change of Branch

- Change of branch at the beginning of III semester is as per VTU norms after 1st/2nd sem results.

Fee Payment and Regulations

1. For 1st year CET and COMED-K students apart from fee paid at KEA/COMED-K, College, Other fee, University related fee to be paid at the time of admission.
2. 1st year Management Quota students have to pay fee as notified at the time of admission.
3. 2nd, 3rd and 4th year students of all Quota/ Branches have to pay tuition and college fee within 1st week of start of odd semester. One week time is given to pay fee with penalty.
4. After the last date (with penalty), students are not considered to attend classes.
5. Any other fee towards VTU exams to be paid as and when it is announced within due date.

Online Fee payment:

Fee payment to the college is made fully CASH LESS

Students can pay the applicable fee as per the circulars of the college which is facilitated by the Canara bank Bill Desk fee payment gateway.

Fee are categorized in to two groups

1. College Admission Fee (Once in a year)
