



 - Identification of members for External Audit Team was under process.

The fitness certificate of the college buses beyond 15 years of manufacturing date are not being renewed citing new motor vehicle act. Therefore 3 long choices buses are in immediate need to cater to the present demand. Considering the long routes through which majority of the buses operate and that at least two trips are required (In actuality 3) the chartered services from KSRTC will not be economical and thus purchasing of new buses is strongly felt. Even if the option for the transportation facility is proposed from the next academic year the need for these buses is very much required. Therefore I request you on behalf of the department to permit the purchase of three long chasis from Ashok Leyland immediately. Ashok LeyLand is recommended keeping in view the maintenance cost as well as running cost compared to Tata make which are present in the department. Approximate cost involved for one bus on road condition will be Rs 25 Lakhs.



Report 2

The following are summary of the tasks undertaken thereafter:

1. NBA committee met frequently to discuss the tasks that are to be taken up in a step by step manner. The tasks were assigned to the departments and it was reviewed periodically. It was decided to submit NBA pre-qualifier during March 2019 and submit SAR during May 2019. Then the Academic year would be 2018-19 and Assessment year would be 2017-18. It was decided to compute the course outcomes for the last three batches: 2012-16, 2013-17 and 2014-18. The proceedings of the NBA core committee meetings were communicated to all the departments.
2. Dr. C G Hemamalini presented the NBA SELF ASSESSMENT REPORT (SAR) to the core committee members during October 2018. All the 10 criteria and the level of the preparation needed at the department level were deliberated in detail. Brain storming session was organized to plan the NBA process in all the departments.
3. Institute Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was being closely monitoring the NBA process. IQAC coordinator was part of the NBA core committee as special invitee and proceedings of the meetings were recorded. In every alternate IQAC meetings NBA process was reviewed and the further course of actions was recommended.
4. NBA audit was conducted during 10 – 12, October 2018 and 29 – 31, December 2018 and the outcomes of the audit and the improvements / updations to be incorporated were communicated to departments.
5. All the depts were asked to submit filled in NBA Pre-qualifier proforma during January 2019 and were analyzed to check the preliminary criteria to be met to apply for NBA.
6. All the departments were informed to prepare NBA SAR version 0 and submit by 16.1.2019. It was decided to concentrate on all the criteria except criteria 3. Criteria 3 include the course attainment computation and it was decided to take up this in the next version of SAR.
7. It was decided to arrange an interaction session with NBA expert to clarify various queries related to the NBA process. Dr. Rajanikanth, Former Principal, MSRIT and NBA Expert was invited for the interaction programme during 24 – 25, January 2019. Sri. S. N. Nagaraja, Secretary, NES inaugurated the programme and informed all the faculty members to actively

involve themselves in NBA process. All the NBA coordinators, HoDs, Professors & Criteria in- charges attended the interaction. Dr. Rajanikanth explained all NBA criteria in detail, discussed about documental evidences, reviewed SAR Version 0 of Computer Science department and made his remarks. He verified the course attainment computation Excel sheet designed by Mr. Chetan KR, Asst. Professor, CS&E and Syed Aftab Ahmed, Asst. Professor, IS & E and suggested the modifications. Also, NBA core committee members conducted a meeting in the second day evening and clarified their doubts. In the second day, 25.1.2019 at 4.00PM concluding session of the interaction was attended by Principal and Sri. S. N. Nagaraja, Secretary, NES. All the members of the core committee were asked to propose the probable date of submission of the final version of NBA SAR and it was proposed by all the members to submit the NBA SAR final version during last week of Feb. 2019.

8. A sub committee was formed to prepare Criteria 8 – First year program (Table 2.). NBA coordinator conducted a meeting with members subcommittee and gave the details of the tasks to be undertaken by the members. Dr. Jalesh Kumar, Member NBA core Committee and Dr. S. V. Sathyanarayana, IQAC Coordinator were designated as the conveners of the subcommittee.

Final Remarks:

Review of next version 3 of SAR of all the departments will be done starting from 2nd April 2019 and finalize the SAR document by 2nd week of April. Get it reviewed by Internal team, Expert from Outside, and incorporate the changes suggested & finalize the SAR document by all departments. We will apply for Pre Qualifier by 1st week of May 2019. From the date of applying Pre Qualifier, we will get two months to submit the final SAR and so will submit the SAR by 1st week of July 2019. With this, NBA Assessment team may visit in Sept 2019 and hence they will consider the Academic Year as 2019-20 for assessment. This will be helpful to us so that we can show results of 2015-19 batch as Assessment year will 2018-19 and all the events happened in 2018-19.

Report 5

Award of Accreditation (TIER II (UG) is as per NBA guideline document enclosed along with this report.

As per the above guidelines, we are eligible to hope for the 2nd one and following is to be fulfilled to get NBA Accreditation for 3 years:

1. The score for the program is greater than or equal to 600 points with minimum 40% marks in Criterion V (Faculty Information and Contributions)
2. At least one Professor or one Associate Professor with Ph.D. degree (on a full-time/regular basis) is available in the respective Department for previous two academic years including current academic year
3. The student faculty ratio in the department under consideration is less than or equal to 1:25 averaged for previous three academic years including current academic year
4. The number of available Ph.D. in the department is greater than or equal to 10% of the required number of faculty averaged for previous two academic years including current academic year

Report 7

During this review and interaction, experts have given review comments, changes to be , also suggested how to prepare, face assessment, many other points.

The following were the common observations:

1. Course Outcomes (COs) and the mapping to Program Outcomes (POs) should be rewritten and attainment computation should be accordingly recomputed.
 2. Program Educational Objectives – PEOs should be re-drafted.
 3. In all the other criteria's some minor changes have been suggested
 4. All the experts given suggestions related to the documental evidences to be produced during the visit.
2. NBA core committee met on 27.5.2018 to review the suggestions given by the experts. Later, it was decided to draft a common procedure to compute CO and PO attainment to be followed by all the departments. All the NBA coordinators were informed to incorporate the changes suggested by the experts and submit the final SAR on or before 10.5.2019. Also, Principal informed all the coordinators that before submitting the pre-qualifier, all the departments should submit the final SAR.
 3. Principal conducted meeting of HoDs on 28.5.2019 and discussed the next action plan elaborately and the following time line was agreed:

Timeline for submission NBA Documents:

1. Submission of Pre-Qualifier : 11th Jun to 15th Jun 2019 (all departments in two separate applications)
 2. Tentative dates for Review of SAR & Mock Assessment : 15th to 20th July 2019

 4. Submission of SAR : 29th to 30th Jul 2019
 5. Possible dates for NBA Team Visit : 5th Sep to 25th Sep 2019
4. A process was drafted to compute CO and PO attainment by Dr. Sabeel Ahmed, NBA coordinator, Dr. S. V. Sathyanarayana, IQAC Coordinator, Dr. Jalesh Kumar, Assoc. Professor, CSE Dept and Member, NBA Committee and circulated to all the faculty members on 3.6.2018. Attainment computation software designed by Mr. Chetan K R, Asst. Professor, CSE was tuned according to the changes defined in the process.
 5. All the departments conducted department level meetings and finalized COs and CO-PO mapping of all the courses and all the faculty members are being computing CO and PO attainments as per the process mentioned in point no.4.

While giving 6th Pay, faculty who had joined with B.E. up to 2008 Dec were given 6th pay while those who joined with B.E. in 2009 and 2010 were given 6th pay after completing PG. This cutoff date is ambiguous.

- In FY 2009-10 and 2010-11, 22 faculty have been appointed as permanent staff in JNNCE .Out of 22 faculty, Five(5)faculty have joined with PG. Their fitments are correct and no action.
- Remaining 17 faculty have been appointed with BE qualification with a condition that they complete PG (M.Tech) in 4 years from the date of joining else increments would be stopped .Accordingly, they were recruited on 5th pay and 6th pay was granted as and when they completed PG.

Issue : Seniority protection:

Post 2011 candidates with PG only were recruited and hence fixing AGP post completion of PG for 2009 & 2010 joiners will loose the seniority in comparison with teaching faculty joining the institution from 2011 onwards.

Solution: Propose to management to consider to fix the AGP dates as a notional fitment from the date of joining (regularization date):
