


- All faculty members regularly entering the attendance

- No. of views of Utube videos are a measure of students involvement in a particular course


. Sri. Nagaraj informed that online teaching shall be interactive and each faculty member should take personal care about each student. Student member Shripad Adiga explained how Utube videos


are helping them about missed classes due to network issues. He also informed that students are also now adjusting to online classes.


