### 3. Proceedings:

1. The Dean academic formally welcomed the new members to the 38<sup>th</sup> meeting and in his initial remarks, presented briefly the highlights of the agenda of the meeting. He further invited the coordinator to continue the proceedings of the meeting.
2. IQAC Coordinator gave a brief review of previous meeting proceedings and the action taken
  - a) Student Performance measures and continuous evaluation
    - A quality monitoring committee for ensuring quality of IA and Evaluation of first year subjects has been made.
    - Mentoring has been strengthened to provide continuous feedback to the parents.
    - Remedial classes for weak students are conducted
  - b) Improving research activities/consultancy/industry institute interaction

Two research projects have been sanctioned one from Mechanical Department under VTU and other from Civil Engg. Department under KSTA.

    - 15 BE projects has been selected by KSCST, IISc, Bengaluru with total amount of 1,02,000
    - Consultancy project for software automation of National College of Pharmacy has been sanctioned to Dept. of CS&E and AIML, JNNCE
    - An MoU for establishing learning academy in collaboration with Dept. of CSE & AIML and Ekatva Innovations Pvt. Ltd. has been formed with objective of industry institute interaction,
  - c) Measure to increase the enrolment in MECH/CIVIL/EEE
    - Project Exhibition for all II PUC students is planned on 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> May 2022
    - Writing articles and using social media on awareness and importance of MECH/CIVIL/EEE courses.
  - d) NBA Visit for Compliance report
    - A mail for NBA team has been received regarding visit of Team on review of Compliance report on 24/6/2022.

- Required file updates at department level is being carried out.

### 3. **Agenda : Result Analysis**

The performance of final year EEE students was below 80%.

#### **Proposal :**

- Performing explorative analysis of results

Principal suggested to show explorative analysis of results in JAMS software and then conduct meeting with Heads of Dept. in analyzing results effectively.

#### **Recommendations :**

- Secretary informed to collect explanation from EEE Dept. and their subsequent plan of action before next meeting

### 4. **Agenda : Placement Analysis**

Dr. Srikanth, Placement HOD explained on good number of offers for final year students.

#### **Proposal :**

- Finding non-placed students
- Exploring package wise analysis

#### **Recommendations :**

- Principal suggested to make interface in JAMS for Placement Dept. to collect placement data and visually represent the data in various parameter.
- Secretary informed to find out reason for non-placed students and conduct activities them to orient them towards placement.

### 5. **Agenda : Admission Analysis**

Admission analysis in terms of opening and closing ranks of students was shown for all the branches. Overall first year admission statistics was also presented.

#### **Recommendations:**

- Improve opening ranks of all branches.
- Improve enrollment of students to all branches under various categories.

### 6. **Agenda : NBA preparation for second visit**

IQAC coordinator informed that a mail from NBA team has been received for review

of Compliance report sent. He informed the present preparations of Departments towards NBA second visit.

**Recommendations:**

- All Faculty to complete their course and personal files.
- All NBA criteria files and P files to be updated soon.
- Keep the addressing made towards the remarks made during first visit.
- Secretary informed to conduct periodical reviews.

**7. Agenda: Updates**

- Grand success of Global Alumni meet conducted on 22/5/22.

**8. Agenda: API Addendum**

It was proposed that there were 2 issues that need to be addressed in present Faculty API for Increments and Promotions:

**(i) Research Guidance – 10 Points**

Issue: Faculty who have not yet done Ph.D or who do not have guideship could not participate in this category.

Resolution:

- Those who have not yet completed Ph.D. should perform Research Inclination. They should present making literature review of 4 peer reviewed indexed journals on their proposed area of research. The presentation shall be evaluated by a committee formed at Department level by HOD.
- Those who have completed Ph.D and do not have guideship should do additional publication to get those points.

**(ii) Increasing Weightage of workshops/FDPs and other activities attended**

Issue: In the API format, current weightage for attending workshops/FDPs 1 week-5 points and 2 week -10 points. Hence each faculty has to either attend 4 one week workshop or 2 two week workshops/FDPs to get allotted 20 points. With current academic overlaps after pandemic, it is

difficult to attend such length of workshops/FDPs.

**Resolution:**

-For attending each 1-week workshop/FDP – 10 points and 2-week workshop/FDP -20 points.

As there were no other subjects, the meeting concluded, with the principal thanking all the members for their active participation.
