

Utilise renewable fuels to prevent global warming, students advised

SHIVAMOGGA: Karnataka Renewable Energy Development Limited Project Engineer D K Dinesh Kumar has suggested people to utilise renewable fuels to prevent global warming.

He noted this while speaking after inaugurating an awareness programme on energy conservation held for engineering college students, jointly organised by Karnataka Renewable Energy Development Limited, and Electrical & Electronics Engineering De-

partment of JNNCE at MBA/MCA auditorium in the City on Friday.

He said, there are many renewable fuels available in the State. Waste from factories can be recycled, and used as fuel.

Engineering students must focus on developing renewable fuels. There is ample scope for research on renewable energies, he added.

Speaking on the occasion, Mysuru-based Rachana N R

Care Company Director Anil Kumar said, gas emitted from industrial units is the reason for the rise in global warming. There is a need to create awareness among people and students about conservation of electricity and energy, he noted.
