Various documents verified by the academic audit committee are: Lesson Plan , Course outcome, CO – PO and CO-I'SO mapping, IA question paper as per format specified by the institution and scheme & solution, IA marks announcement, Mentor meeting reports, Attendance Register & Syllabus coverage as per the plan in course diary.

After the verification process, summarized report is prepared by the convener of the academic monitoring committee and communicated to the respective HoD. If any discrepancy is found, the respective faculty will be intimated to do the corrections within one week of the audit. The follow up of corrections is taken care by HOD.


11. Universal Human Value Cell
